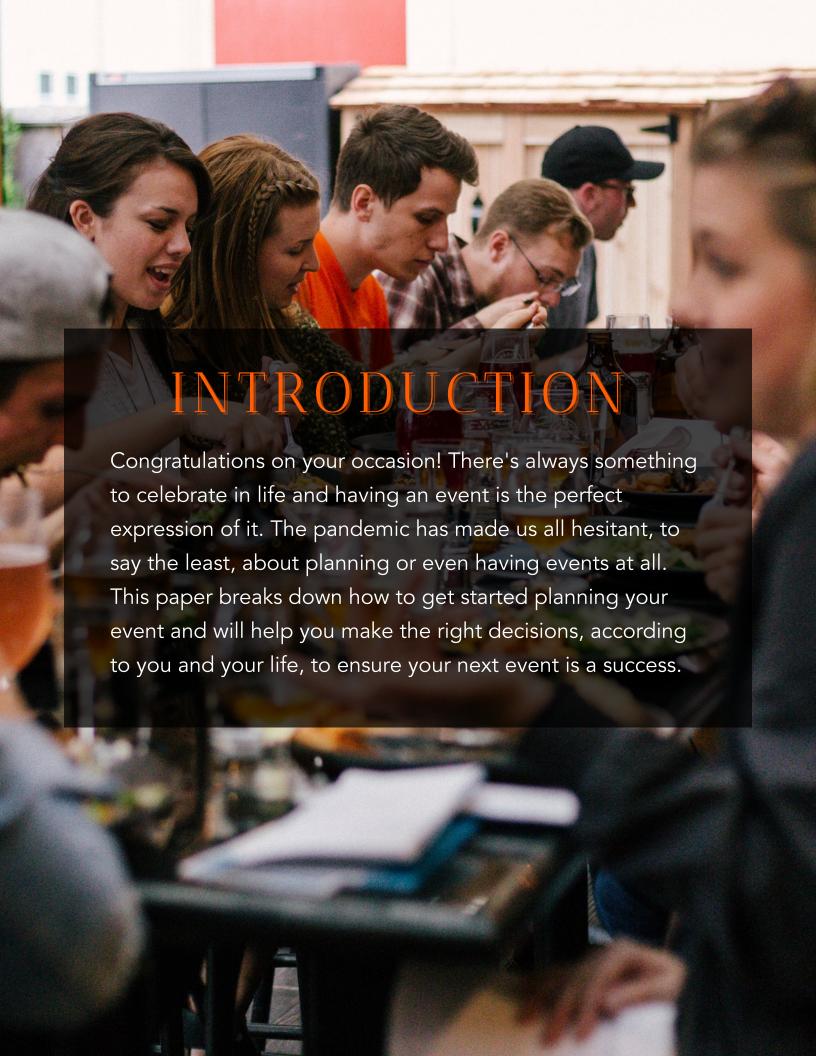

## WHO DO I HIRE?

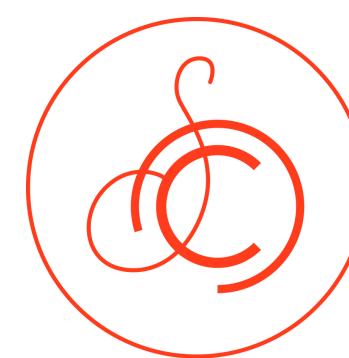
Now it's time to decide who to hire. As was mentioned before, you should leave the three most expensive elements (food, decor, and venue) to the professionals.
